## I. CALL TO ORDER

Having a quorum, the BAC-A Meeting for the above-mentioned proposed contract was called to order at 10:00 A.M. with the BAC-A Vice-Chairperson, Ailyne C. Agtuca-Selda, presiding.

## II. BUSINESS MATTERS

The Vice-Chairperson welcomed and acknowledged the presence of the BAC-A Members, the TWG, and the Secretariat and informed the body that the meeting was regarding the Pre-Bidding Conference for the Construction Bayuyan Earthfill Dam and its Appurtenant Structures in Region 6 under Small Reservoir Irrigation Project Invitation to Bid No. R1-BSRIPD-C-34. He then instructed the Secretariat to discuss the agenda of the meeting.

- The Vice-Chairperson then instructed the BAC-A Secretariat for the presentation of the background of the project and all the requirements to be submitted by the bidders.
- Ms. Elaine P. Villanueva informed that Mr. Martin Ian P. Mariano of the BAC-Secretariat will present the slides of the requirements to be submitted by the bidder while Mr. Rory F. Avance presented the background of the project.
- Mr. Mariano, Member of Secretariat, presented the General Information, and background of the project stating that the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is PhP 358,320,821.39 and the contract duration is 919 Calendar Days including 246 unworkable days. He also clarified all the documentary requirements to be submitted by the

bidders i.e., Eligibility/Technical Documents (Envelope 1) and the Financial Documents (Envelope 2).

- Mr. Mariano reminded the bidders to fill-up and attach the required documents such as the CTC and Government-Issued ID in the Omnibus Sworn Statement. He also noted that all of the Major Equipment listed in the minimum requirement must be in A1 condition and at least 30% must be owned by the Bidder. No replacement shall be made throughout the contract duration without prior written approval of NIA. He added that for the Key Personnel, once the Contract has been awarded, no replacement shall be allowed by NIA until after fifty percent (50%) of the project has been completed, except for justifiable reason.
- After the presentation, the Vice-Chairperson asked the prospective bidders one by one for questions and/or clarifications regarding the proposed contract.

## 1. PHESCO

Q1: The representatives asked whether site inspection is required and time where they can visit.

A1: Mr. Mariano informed that as reflected in the bidding documents site inspection is required and they can coordinate with Engr. Rory F. Avance for the details contact numbers were already presented. The Vice-Chairperson the same must be signed by designated NIA official and employee. Mr. Avance likewise added that they are available 24/7.

Q2: Ms. Colleen Sales clarified as to the kind of the required Material Testing Equipment being referred to and whether there is still a need for a certification from a third party.

A2: BAC member Lydia S. Esguerra replied that the equipment is called the Field Density Testing Equipment. She added that any accredited testing facility or equipment will do. The Vice-Chairperson added that any proof of ownership will suffice indicating that the same is 30% owned by the contractor coupled with a certification of availability of equipment for the duration of the project.

Q3: Mr. Ely Garcia pointed the apparent discrepancy of the project amount the presentations from the NIA Central Office and Field Office.

A3: Mr. Avance replied that the one presented from the field office was the over-all project cost while the data from the CO is for the embankment which is the subject of the Pre -Bidding Conference.

Q4: Ms. Sales clarified whether the equipment with asterisks must be on A1 condition and must be owned by the contractor.

A4: The Vice-Chairperson affirmed.

## 2. TRYST BUILDERS' ENTERPRISES

Q5: Ms. Pamela Orduña clarified on the note that states that the equipment must be 30% owned by the bidders.

A5: Ms. Esguerra and the Vice-Chairperson informed that the committee will discuss the matter and will notify the bidders through a supplemental bid notice.

Q6: Ms. Orduña stated that their backhoe was converted from 2.50 cu.m. to 1.50 cu.m. and queried whether the same is allowed.

A6: TWG member Mr. Reynaldo D. Baloloy answered in the affirmative.

Q7: Ms. Orduña queried on the minimum capacity of the portable batching plant, cargo truck and grout mixer.

A7: TWG member Mr. Baloloy informed that it was not specified in the presentation and would be better to bring the matter for discussion and the same was concurred by the Vice-Chairperson.

Having no more questions the Vice-Chairperson informed that the BAC Secretariat will provide the email address as well as the Fax No. where the bidders can send written clarifications on the matter on or before May 31, 2021.

In addition, the Vice Chairman instructed everyone to be mindful of the following:

1. PhilGEPS Registration must be Platinum membership. No attachment needed unless some documents are expired.
2. For the statement of on-going projects, there is no need for attachment, only the statement of the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) for similar project, requiring attachments as stated in the Bid Documents,




