Bidders must completely and properly fill-out all required details in the NIA Prescribed Forms, and notarize all necessary documents accordingly.

Written requests and/or clarifications may be submitted until October 7, 2024.

Supplemental Bid Bulletin/s will be posted on or before October 15, 2024.

IV. INQUIRIES:

AGRI.IO (formerly, Agrilever Philippines Corp.) and The TOMMORROW COMPANIES, INC.

Q1- Form of Bid Security- Please confirm that, in order to satisfy the Bid Security Requirement, a bidder may opt to submit only an original copy of a notarized Bid Securing Declaration, in the form provided under the Bid Documents (p.43), in lieu of other security in the form cash, manager's check, bank guarantee, irrevocable letter of credit, or surety bond.

A1: The bidder has the option to choose among the prescribed forms of bid security. In case of Bid Securing Declaration, the bidders should ensure that the same is properly filled up and notarized.

Q2-Bid Price- the Bid Form requires that the total bid price should include and itemize the cost of all taxes, such as VAT, income tax, local taxes, and other fiscal levies and duties. We note, however that the tables under the Price Schedule do not provide columns for setting out the cost of taxes. Please confirm whether the bidders should add appropriate columns for create an additional table setting out the cost of applicable taxes.

A2: Column number. 7 (For Goods Offered from Abroad) of the form where the bidder should indicate tax related information.

Q3-Payment Terms- Section VI. (Schedule of Requirements), item 5 (Payment Terms) of the Bid Documents (p.27) states that the payment shall be made 30 days after issuance of Certificate of Final Acceptance by the Procuring Entity subject to the submission of complete supporting documents. However, Part XI (Terms of Payment), item 2 (Payment to the Supplier) of the document entitled Terms of Reference provides for 50% -25% -15%-10% milestone payments. Please confirm that the payment terms to the winning bidder under this project will be implemented in accordance with the milestone payments table under the Terms of Reference.

A3: That the supplier/contractor will be paid within thirty (30) calendar days after his/her submission of complete requirements per progress billing period.

Q4-Performance Security-Please confirm whether the Performance Security requirement is already satisfied by the NIA's retention of 10% of the project price under the milestone payments table in the Terms of Reference or whether the winning Bidder should a post a separate performance security.

A4: Separate Performance Security should be posted.

Q5-Post-Qualification Requirements- For bidders who are unincorporated joint ventures composed of a Filipino corporation (60%) and a non-resident foreign corporation (40%), please confirm that it is sufficient for the bidder to submit only the latest income and business tax return filed and paid through the BIR eFPS of the Filipino corporation in order to satisfy this post-qualification requirement.

A5: BAC-A Provisional Member, Engr. Marcial G. Gealone, Jr. stated that there is an ongong discussion on the matter and the question will be answered with accordingly.

Q6-Warranty- Please confirm whether the Warranty requirement is already satisfied by the NIA's retention of 10% of the project price under the milestone payments table in the Terms of Reference or whether the winning Bidder should post a separate warranty. We note that 62.1 of the GPRA allows the Warranty to be in the form of retention money; "The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by either retention money in an amount equivalent to at least one percent (1%) but not to exceed five percent (5%) of every progress payment, or a special bank guarantee equivalent to at least one percent (1%) but not to exceed five percent of the total contract price.

A6: : BAC-A Provisional Member, Engr. Marcial G. Gealone, Jr. replied that the bidder can opt to submit a bank guarantee or opt for the 10% retention of the project price, whichever is convenient to the interested party.

Q7-Post-Qual Requirements- For bidders who are unincorporated joint ventures composed of a Filipino corporation (60%) and a non-resident foreign corporation (40%), please confirm that the joint venture members do not need to incorporate a joint venture entity with the SEC if the joint venture is selected as the winning bidder.

A7: BAC-A Provisional Member, Engr. Marcial G. Gealone, Jr. stated that there is an on-gong discussion on the matter and the question will be answered in writing.

Q8-Post-Qual Requirements- For bidders who are unincorporated joint ventures composed of a Filipino corporation (60%) and a non-resident foreign corporation (40%), please confirm whether the non-resident foreign member must obtain SEC registration for purposes of postqualification.

A8: BAC-A Provisional Member, Engr. Marcial G. Gealone, Jr. stated that there is an ongong discussion on the matter and the question will be answered in writing.

Q9-Contract Implementation-For bidders who are unincorporated joint ventures composed of a Filipino corporation (60%) and a non-resident foreign

corporation (40%), please confirm that all the contract payments can be made to the Filipino joint venture member.

A9: : BAC-A Provisional Member, Engr. Marcial G. Gealone, Jr. stated that there is an on-gong discussion on the matter and the question will be answered in writing.

Q10-Performance Security-Please confirm whether there is a specific language that the Procuring Entity requires.

A10: The BAC requires the winning bidder to submit a PS after the issuance of NOA.

Q11-Terms of Reference- Please confirm that the Terms of Reference forms part of the Bidding Documents—relevant to the milestone payments to the supplier.

Bidder's Qualification: Please confirm whether the bidder would have to comply with this list in addition to the technical specifications. If so, where do we place it? Do we add it to the Comparative Specifications List or do we make a separate table for it?

A11: no reply. (assumed that the same will be answered formally in writing).

Q12: What are the *valid and current licenses* applicable/required for the undertaking as per Section 10 a.6 of the Bid Data Sheet, also if foreign issued licenses accepted?

A12: All licenses which are applicable and required in the ordinary course of business, while for foreign licenses, the BSWM representative stated that the same can be managed.

Q13: The representative inquired whether there is a *specific template for letter of credit* required by NIA.

A13: The BSWM representative replied that he is not aware if there is a required template but added that a Supplemental Bid Bulletin if there will be prescribed changes.

KOMUNIDAD

The representative inquired on the NIA mandatory specifications particularly:

1. Weather Satellites & Forecasting Capabilities "Owned and operate their own weather satellites (not contracted) that provide radar and microwave capabilities with the following specifications"

Also, inquired on the following whether the procuring entity is expecting "international bidder," as to how and who will process the satellite information for web/mobile application or is it just the satellite output that will be utilized.

The TWG replied that the satellite output will be utilized.

The representative then stated that they have already a system in placed all over Metro Manila and being used by several LGUs/municipalities he likewise stated they can provide services at a lower cost which is good for a six-year subscription.

He also informed the TWG that the accuracy rate of their weather forecasting is 80-85%.

The TWG informed the representative that the need is for a weather forecasting which is highly specific and accurate for 0-6 hours and capable the accuracy of prediction is good for fourteen (14) days.

The representative expressed his hope that a Filipino company will be given consideration or priority in a public bidding.

The TWG informed the representative that he is free to join the bidding if he possesses all the minimum qualifications.

Having no other matters for discussion the meeting ended at 11:40 AM.
