Delivery of the Goods is required within Sixty (60) Calendar Days from receipt of the Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed a single contract within three (3) years from the deadline of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project with a value of at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).

- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
 - Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
- 4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the National Irrigation Administration and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given during office hours 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Mondays to Fridays.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on *November 29, 2024 to December 18, 2024* from the given address and website/s below and upon presentation of the following requirements:







- a) Letter of Intent (LOI) from the owner/authorized managing officer indicating the name of the employee authorized to purchase the bid documents. The LOI must contain the official mailing address, contact number, and e-mail address of the company;
- b) Company ID of the authorized employee; and
- c) Payment to the NIA Cashier a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (PHP 50,000.00).
- 6. The National Irrigation Administration will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on *December 6, 2024; 10:00 A.M.* at NIA BAC-A Conference Room, 6th Floor, Building "A", NIA Complex, EDSA, Diliman, Quezon City which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC-A Secretariat through manual submission at the office address as indicated below on or before *December 18, 2024; 10:00 AM*. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 8. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 15.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on *December 18, 2024; 10:30 AM* at NIA BAC-A Conference Room, 6th Floor, Building "A", NIA Complex, EDSA, Diliman, Quezon City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

The National Irrigation Administration reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
