II. CONFIRMATION OF QUORUM

The BAC Secretariat acknowledged the presence of the following BAC-A members: (1) Robert C. Suguitan (2) Mr. Albine Dave V. Jubilado ; (3) Engr. Eusebio S. Villamanto. With three of the members present, the BAC Secretariat confirmed the presence of a quorum.

III. CALL TO ORDER

Having a quorum, the BAC-A pre-procurement conference for the above-mentioned proposed contract was called to order at 10:15 A.M. by the BAC-A Chairperson, Robert C. Suguitan.

IV. BUSINESS MATTERS

The Chairperson welcomed and acknowledged the presence of the BAC-A members, the members of the Technical Working Group, and the BAC Secretariat and informed the body that the meeting was regarding the *Pre-Bidding Conference for the Supply and Delivery of Two (2) Units Brand New Passenger Van and Eleven (11) units Brand New Pick-up Truck for NIA-Magat River Integrated Irrigation System (MARIIS) Invitation to Bid No. NIACO-S-16*. He then instructed the Secretariat to discuss the agenda of the meeting.

Technical Documents

Statement of All its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid; and

Statement of the Bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid, in accordance with ITB Clause 5.3.

The Bidder must have completed, within five (5) years prior to the deadline of submission and receipt of bids, a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the ABC or at least two (2) similar contracts and the aggregate contract amounts should be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of ABC having the largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least twenty five percent (25%) of the ABC.

Contracts similar to the Project refer to: **Supply and Delivery of Brand-New Passenger Van/Commuter Van and/or Brand-New Pick-up Truck**

The two statements required shall indicate for each contract the following:

- (1) name of the contract;
- (2) date of the contract;
- (3) contract duration;
- (4) owner's name;
- (5) kinds of Goods;
- (6) For Statement of Ongoing Contracts – amount of contract and value of outstanding contracts;
- (7) For Statement of SLCC – amount of completed contract/s, adjusted to current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA's) consumer price index, if necessary for the purpose of meeting the SLCC requirement;
- (8) Date of delivery; and
- (9) For Statement of SLCC – end user's acceptance, or official receipt(s), or sales invoice issued for the contract, which shall be attached to the Statement of SLCC.

Original copy of Bid Security - The bid security shall be limited to original copy of Notarized Bid Securing Declaration or one (1) other form in accordance with the following amount:

Original duly signed and notarized Sworn statement in accordance with Section 25.3 of the IRR of RA 9184 and using the form prescribed in Section VIII-A. Bidding Forms - Omnibus Sworn Statement, and if applicable, Original Notarized Secretary's Certificate in case of a corporation, partnership, or cooperative; or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder.

Financial Documents

Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) computation or a committed Line of Credit from a universal or commercial bank in lieu of its NFCC computation.

Class "B" Documents

If applicable, original duly signed and notarized Joint Venture Agreement (JVA) in case the joint venture is already in existence, or duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners in accordance with Section 23.1(b) of the IRR.

Other Documentary Requirements:

Duly signed and notarized Sworn Statement as to the existence and location of After-Sales Service Facility in Region II with a business permit named after the manufacturer/ exclusive distributor/ authorized reseller in the Philippines; and

Exclusive distributorship certificate; or
Certification of Authority as a Reseller of Products Offered (if the Bidder is not the exclusive distributor) issued by the manufacturer;

Original duly signed and accomplished Financial Bid Form in accordance with NIA Prescribed Form; and

Original duly signed and accomplished Price Schedule in accordance with NIA Prescribed Form.

Other documentary requirements under RA No. 9184 (as applicable)
For foreign bidders claiming by reason of their country's extension of reciprocal rights to Filipinos] Certification from the relevant government office of their country stating that Filipinos are allowed to participate in government procurement activities for the same item or product.

Certification from the DTI if the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder or Domestic Entity.

He likewise reminded the prospective bidders of the following:

That for the submission of bids, Original, copies 1 and 2 of the first and second component of the bid must reflect the following:

- Table of contents;
- Sequential order of documents in line with Section VIII "Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents";
- Proper tabbing and binding of documents; and
- Copies 1 and 2 must be certified true copy of the original document.

Use and fill out completely the NIA Prescribed Forms. Electronic copy of the forms are readily available at the Office of the BAC-A Secretariat upon purchase of the Bidding Documents.

For sworn statements, please fill out all the required information (e.g. government identification card used and its number) in the Jurat portion.

Also, that:

Written requests and/or clarifications may be submitted until October 2, 2023, at the Office of the BAC-A Secretariat, 6th Floor, NIA Bldg. A, Diliman, Quezon City, or through e-mail (bac-a@nia.gov.ph).

Supplemental Bid Bulletin/s shall be posted on or before October 4, 2023, if there is any.

BAC-A communications shall be through the e-mail address registered upon purchase of Bidding Documents. Nonetheless, the original copy of the letter shall be delivered to your office through mailing service.

Section 55.1 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184 states that "Decisions of the BAC at any stage of the procurement process may be questioned by filing a request for reconsideration within the three (3) calendar days upon receipt of written notice or upon verbal notification," in this case, the e-mail receipt date shall be the reckoning date.

The notices/communications sent via e-mail shall be considered received on the day or the day after it was sent unless there is a sending failure report from the email provider.

IV. CLARIFICATIONS/ COMMENTS

Q1: Mr. Rommel Valdez, representative from SJ Legacy Motors Inc. inquired if there is any prescribed color for the van.

A1: Engr. Jayson Pasumala of the TWG, replied that there is no particular color and the manufacturer's standard will suffice.

Q2: The representative from Toyota Quezon Ave. queried as to the possibility that the delivery date be extended from forty-five (45) days to ninety calendar (90) days.

A2: Engr. Pasumala replied, that the TWG will discuss the request in a meeting called for that purpose and will take into consideration the quantity of the vehicles.

The Chairperson added that since only two (2) units of vans are involved he is of the opinion that there is a strong chance that the vehicles will be available.

Q3: Representative from SJ Legacy Motors Inc. inquired as to the type of wheel of the vehicle.

A3: TWG member, Engr. Pasumala replied that the wheel is alloy type and if steel is available will be fine.

The Chairperson then stated that in order to formalize the specifications table, a supplemental bid bulletin will be issued to clarify the matter.


He also instructed the TWG to clarify and be specific in the Supplemental Bid Bulletin the seating arrangement/modality of the passengers in the van to avoid confusion.

Mr. Andrew Ford Palatan of SJ Legacy Motors Inc. informed the group that it has come to their attention that there is a shortage of supply of vans coming from Japan, China and Korea and the supply will normalize comes January 2024, just within the period for the issuance of Notice to Proceed.

V. ADJOURNMENT

Having no other matters for discussion the meeting ended at 11:15 PM.
